Christian Care Honored with Local Award

Christian Care was recently honored by the Rock Island City Council as both the 2019 Organization of the Year and as the overall 2019 Citizen of the Year. The shelter was presented with 2 plaques and was given the privilege of being the Grand Marshal in Rock Island's Labor Day Parade.

"Christian Care was chosen as the overall award winner because of their deep commitment to providing exceptional services for the homeless and the Rock Island community and for their collaboration with their partners toward their goal of ending homelessness in the Quad Cities," said Eudell Watts III, last year's Citizen of the Year winner, as he presented Christian Care with the award. "Christian Care has been providing services for over a century and the passion and caring of their staff endures in the tradition of their founder"



Executive Director Frank Roe shared he is proud that we are staying the course with our founder Guy Rodgers' legacy while also looking for new ways to make an impact. "It is an honor to be recognized by the city of Rock Island," said Roe. "This award says to me 'We recognize the integral role Christian Care plays in our community by providing safe shelter to men experiencing homelessness, a meal site to those experiencing hunger, as well as many other vital services." Roe pointed to the new efforts made to impact our community, including a new dorm, a parish nurse program, and a mobile food pantry. He said Christian Care will continue to look "into how in a small way we might be able to improve the quality of life and enhance the impact for low-income families and individuals."



Steve Gottcent, Community Outreach Coordinator, said this honor was a great boost of encouragement for the team. "There are communities elsewhere in our country where the solution to homelessness is a 1-way bus ticket," Gottcent said. "This award sends a message from Rock Island that they are proud of what we do and happy we are here to serve our local community." 
