2021 Projects

Pardon our Dust....



In the first part of the year, construction will begin on the first of two major projects. A public shower will be added to one of our restrooms locat-

ed in our front entry way. A public shower is a much needed addition to the Illinois Quad Cities for those experiencing homelessness.



The second project will be a resource lab and library. The lab will include computers, printers and access to assistance from a staff member. The

resource lab will give residents access to building a resume, applying for employment and benefits. This will be a huge step forward in self-sustainment.

Brenton's Story



This is the story of a young man who had to grow up really fast after multiple run-ins with the law and 14 years of drug addiction. Brenton came to Christian Care as part of the Rock Island County Drug Court Program after being in jail for four months, homeless, and unemployed. Since arriving at Christian Care, Brenton has demonstrated stellar qualities. He was able to phase up in the drug court program and accomplish all of his goals.

Brenton has been successful in maintaining his sobriety with the help of his sponsor and support system. Likewise, he was able to obtain and maintain full-time employment. His relationship with his children and family are slowly getting better as he is able to communicate and visit with them whenever possible. When asked, "What has Christian Care done for you?", he answered, "A solid structure & stepping stone for me, something that I needed."


