My Story

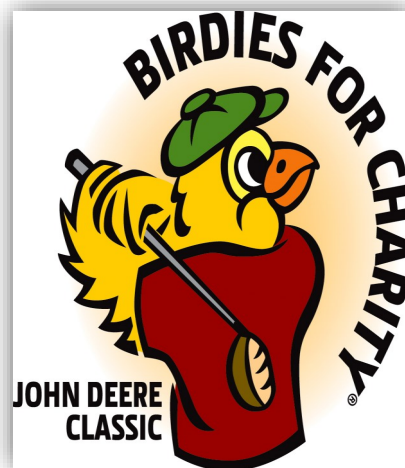
MEET DEBORAH

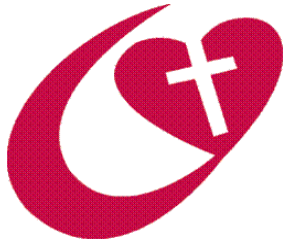


Patriot Guard Riders

Martha's House has served 21 residents since opening in January 2022. Two of these beds are dedicated to RI County Drug & Mental Health Court Systems.



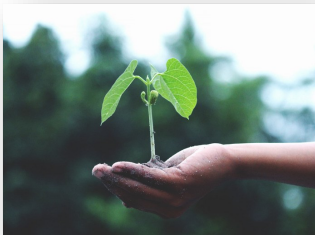
